

SAFETY REVIEW

Q: What should you do at an alley or driveway?

A: Slow down. Look and listen for cars. Check the alley mirrors, if available, and STOP if you see a car coming.

Q: Where should you walk or ride?

A: Children should always walk or ride on the sidewalk, not in the street.

Q: Where should you cross the street?

In a crosswalk, at a corner, or with a crossing guard. Never in the middle of the block.

Q: What should you do before you cross?

A: Stop, look, and listen. Look left, look right, look behind you (for turning cars), and look left again. Look drivers in the eye to be sure they see you. If there is a traffic light at the intersection, follow the signals and only cross when the walk signal is illuminated. Walk your bike across busy intersections.

Q: What clothing is best for walking or riding?

A: Bright colors, or reflective clothing at night. Don't ride in sandals or flip flops. Be sure your shoelaces are tied!

Q: Who should wear a helmet?

A: All riders, not just new riders, or children.
